You will connect with peers from diverse backgrounds and build vital professional, social, and intercultural competencies. Students completing the program will receive certificates of completion and will be invited to enroll in the Department of State's International Exchange Alumni Network and the Localized international professional development platform. They will also receive invitations to additional learning, exchange, and networking opportunities from PATHWAYS and Empower Peace.
